The Education Consortium is a large and complex organisation created by the Department of Education and Vocational Training and the Barcelona City Council to manage and support the city's schools and educational community. The start of this school year includes a novel aspect: the **general consultation portal for families and citizens**. This new channel for requests, which you will find at this link or through the contact page on the Consortium's website, simplifies the school system's capacity to respond to questions and unifies all incoming general queries in a single space organised by topics. We hope that this portal will be easy and clear for you and will help us to provide more personal and agile responses.

Furthermore, enclosed in this letter you will find **basic information related to the people and services that can provide support** for your children's education, the roles they carry out and the available means of contact.

Barcelona is home to 12,000 professionals who work to educate the city's children and youth and guide them in their development. Over the past few weeks we have been preparing for the start of the school year, and in the coming months we will continue to work together with all our families to make progress on what is most important: your children's education and well-being.

The professionals at your school

The tutor is the main point of reference when it comes to knowing how your child is progressing in school and regarding their educational needs. The tutor provides personalised guidance for students in coordination with the other teachers and professionals at the school. The administration supports them, promotes the educational objectives and listens to families' needs and concerns.

What is the role of the education inspection office?

The Education Inspection Office oversees the education system as a whole and is responsible for the supervision, assessment and evaluation of schools and educational services. In the city of Barcelona, this office operates by districts, where it supports and works with schools and educational services to promote projects to improve educational quality, inclusion and equity. Its objective is to ensure that regulations are properly applied, that rights are exercised and that the subsequent obligations are met. The office also attends to the interests and needs of the educational community.



Who are the educational psychologists? What support do they offer?


Educational psychologists form part of the educational psychology counselling and guidance teams (EAP). Together with the employees at your child's school, they can help you understand your child's needs, and what resources or support are most appropriate, both in school and outside of it (e.g. leisure activities). Other specific education teams and services* work with schools and support the diverse needs of pupils in primary and secondary education. You can contact some of them through the EAP.

What is the Barcelona Education Consortium?

We are the educational administration in the city of Barcelona, formed by the Department of Education and Vocational Training and the Barcelona City Council. We manage the 300 public schools in the city. As the city's educational administration, we serve public and state-subsidised schools. As family members, you have several channels available (online through the newly created queries and requests channel, by phone, and through the Family Assistance Office by appointment) to address your requests and needs.
